Directions: From intersection of State Highway 18 (Rim of the World Drive) and State Route 173 (Lakes Edge Road), Follow SR-173 to Lake Arrowhead. Follow SR-173 around Lake Arrowhead, past Papoose Lake and the Marina until you come to the Mountains Community Hospital. Follow the signs to the hospital. At the stop sign, turn left onto Rouse Ranch Road, and look for the entrance to the North Shore Work Center within 100 Ft on your right. (If you enter the North Shore campground, you have gone too far.)
