

Join the Orange County Dualies for a self-guided tour through the San Jacinto Forest, Lake Hemet and Idyllwild. Many people are unaware that there is a large variety of off-road riding so close to Orange County. This is your chance to explore this area and help the Dualies raise donations for charity. The ride starts in Banning and consists of OHV roads, 4WD trails, single track and short sections of highway. Both easy and hard way loops are available to challenge riders of all skill levels. Total distance will vary from 80 to 130 miles depending on the loops selected. The longest distance to fuel (hard loop) is approximately 80 miles. Lunch is on-your-own in Idyllwild.







The ride is open to street legal Dual-Sport & Adventure motorcycles with DOT tires and USFS approved spark arrestors that meet the sound standard of 96db.
