Come out and explore the *San Jacinto Forest, Lake Hemet and Idyllwild*

This charity fundraiser ride will be self-guided tour open to street legal Dual-Sport & Adventure motorcycles with DOT tires and USFS approved spark arrestors that meet current sound standards of 94 dB/A. The ride starts in Banning, the route will consist of jeep and fire roads, OHV roads, 4WD trails and easy-to-challenging single track. Both easy way and hard way loops are available to challenge riders of all levels. Mileage will vary from 75 to 165 miles depending on whether all loops are ridden. Most people probably are unaware that there is a large variety of off-road riding so close to Orange County. This is your chance to come out and explore this area and help the *Dualies* raise donations for charity.

Lunch is on-your-own in Idyllwild CA. GPS will be your only method of route navigation. If you do not have a GPS, there will be many other riders that have them and we will attempt to pair you up with other riders.

Receive a *Dualies Commemorative T-shirt with your Donation* and early sign-up when received before May 1st. Start and finish are at *Coyne Powersports* in Banning, CA with morning sign up starting at 7:00 AM. First rider out at 7:30 AM. Last rider out at 9:15 AM. 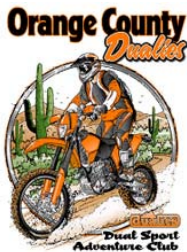
